ELIGIBILITY AND SPECIFICATIONS

The **STUDENT** division of the **Sculpture Show** is open to public school, private school and home schooled students. There are TWO student categories:

Junior class: Grades K-6 - Senior class: Grades 7-12

***STUDENTS 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER MUST ENTER AS ADULTS**

Any artwork accepted into a previous AAOC juried competition is ineligible. Work must be original and have been completed within the past three years. Qualified work shall be an original sculpture and in any medium. Please call with any questions.

STUDENT ENTRY FEE: (Nonrefundable) Checks payable to AAOC 1st entry \$10, Additional entries (up to 2) \$5/item, total # 3.

Note: Items may be priced for sale of labeled NFS.

SUBMISSION: Art images should be sent in the form of a digital photo. Deadline for entries is **Sunday, June 25, 2017 (midnight)**.

DELIVERY: Accepted artwork must be delivered to the AAOC, Gallery 104 on **Saturday, July 8, 2017 from 1-4 pm**.

SPECIFICATIONS: Wall hanging pieces may not have exposed sharp edges touching the wall and shall have multi-stranded wire appropriate for the weight of the piece, securely attached. Loose ends of wire shall be taped to prevent scraping walls. Textile art and any other free hanging art must have the appropriate hanger for support. Arrangements must be made for hanging artwork exceeding 35 lbs (unsuitable for wall hanging system). A limited number of standard pedestals are available. If sculpture requires a unique pedestal of display stand, it must be provided upon delivery. Entries are limited to 32 inches in length, width or depth and shall not exceed 100 lbs. Special requirements must be specified in written detail and be considered as deemed feasible.

For any artwork sold during exhibition at Gallery 104, a commission of 40% of the sales price will be retained by AAOC. The balance will be paid to the artist within 30 days of close of show. Gallery 104 juried in artists will retain the same commission plan as their galley contract.

Any artwork left at Gallery 104 past 30 days of the close of the show, unless the parties agree otherwise, will be considered a donation to the AAOC subject to sale for fundraising purposes.

I consent and authorize AAOC to interview, photograph, and videotape my artwork and I further consent to and authorize AAOC to release, publish, exhibit, or reproduce such photographs, and videotapes for use in public relations, news articles, telecasts, press releases, or education, advertising, research at any time in any form or media, whether now known or later discovered, including but not limited to the AAOC website, fundraising, or any other purpose by AAOC and/or its affiliates.
